

# Lake County Board of Elections Questions and Issues Filings

**November 5, 2024 General Election. Updated: 7/26/2024**

**Please note that the language below is only a summary.**

Order of questions/issues: state; municipal; township; school and other districts; and county

## **Issue #**

### **Eastlake City (12 pcts.)**

0.5 Mill Renewal Levy – Fire – collecting \$198,000 annually – amounting to \$8 for each \$100,000 of the county auditor's appraised value – 5 years – commencing in 2025, first due in 2026.

### **Kirtland City (4 pcts.)**

Proposed Charter Amendment - Shall Article VI of the Charter of the City of Kirtland, Ohio be amended to increase Council's authority to levy a municipal income tax from two percent (2.00%) to the rate of two and twenty-five hundredths percent (2.25%)? If approved, any income tax levied in excess of two percent (2.00%) must be allocated to the City's Road Improvement and Maintenance Program and shall only be in effect through December 31, 2045.

### **Mentor City (35 pcts.)**

Proposed Change in Zoning #1 - Shall Ordinance No. 24-O-042 amending the Codified Ordinances of the City of Mentor, 2006, as amended, and the official Zoning Map to rezone an approximate 8.16 acre area of 6010 Heisley Road, Permanent Parcel Number 16-B-064-0-00-023-0, located at the northwesterly corner of the intersection of Heisley and Hendricks Roads, from M-1, Light Manufacturing, to B-2, General Business, pursuant to development plan and further conditions be approved?

### **Mentor City (35 pcts.)**

Proposed Change in Zoning #2 - Shall Ordinance No. 24-O-043 to amend the codified ordinances of the City of Mentor, 2006, as amended, and the official Zoning Map by the rezoning of approximately 14.5 acres located south of Adkins Road and northwest of the Reynolds Road/State Route 2 interchange from R-4, Single Family Residential District, to PRD, Planned Residential Development Overlay, pursuant to a development plan permitting the construction of 45 homes and a clubhouse, be approved?

5.25 Mills Additional Levy – police – collecting \$357,000 annually - amounting to \$184 for each \$100,000 of the county auditor’s appraised value – 5 years – commencing in 2024, first due in 2025.

**Perry Township Road District (4 pcts.)**

2.9 Mills Renewal Levy – general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing, and repair of streets, roads, and bridges – collecting \$510,000 annually – amounting to \$83 for each \$100,000 of the county auditor’s appraised value – 5 years – commencing in 2024, first due in 2025.

**Concord Township (15 pcts.)**

3.9 Mills Additional Levy – Fire – collecting \$3,284,000 annually – amounting to \$137 for each \$100,000 of the county auditor’s appraised value – 5 years – commencing in 2024, first due in 2025.

**Perry Township Precinct A (1 pct.)**

Local Option (Sunday Sales) Shall the sale of wine and mixed beverages and spirituous liquor be permitted for sale on Sunday by High Vibe Supply, L.L.C., (dba Halcyon Ledges), an applicant for a D-6 liquor permit, who is engaged in the business of operating a restaurant at 4291 S. Ridge Road, 1st Floor and Patio, Perry (Perry Township), Ohio 44081 in this precinct?

**Lake County School Financing District (59 pcts.+ Geauga)**

4.9 Mills Renewal Levy – current expenses for educational programs – collecting \$6,018,000 annually – amounting to \$59 for each \$100,000 of the county auditor’s appraised value – 5 years – commencing 2025, first due in 2026.

**Lake County (ADAMHS District) (163 pcts.)**

0.9 Mill Renewal Levy – operation of community addiction services providers and community mental health services providers, and the acquisition, construction, renovation, financing, maintenance, and operation of alcohol and drug addiction facilities and mental health facilities in Lake County – collecting \$5,464,000 annually – amounting to \$21 for each \$100,000 of the county auditor’s appraised value – 10 years – commencing in 2025, first due in 2026
