Commissioner Troy stated there are approximately 650 manufacturing companies in Lake County and they are always looking for good workers. Manufacturing companies are working with Lakeland Community College and Auburn Career Center to prepare future employees for manufacturing jobs. They are very important to our local economy.

This event is a collaboration between local government and its citizens in order to protect our land and water, valuable resources, and we look forward to providing these special collections for the public in future years. Commissioner Troy stated that the Commissioners received a correspondence from the EPA regarding the Lake County Solid Waste District management and they received positive reviews of our program. The recycling program is on target. The County continues to do what is necessary to protect the environment and stay in compliance with the Ohio EPA.

<u>NEW BUSINESS</u>: - Commissioner Troy reported that CCAO Joint Elections Committee recently met and discussed the electronic poll books.
