NEW BUSINESS: - Commissioner Troy announced that NOPEC recently entered into an agreement with NextEra Energy for three years. First Energy withdrew their contract from the NOPEC program that serves 500,000 customers in 13 Ohio counties. NextEra is a Florida-based company with a local office here in Ohio. NOPEC members will continue to receive the benefits of NOPEC membership which have resulted in about \$250 million of electric cost savings. Customers should expect to receive their opt-out notices for service under the new program within the next few weeks. This is a requirement by law. The advice is to ignore the opt-out notices. If participants do nothing, they will continue to be part of the NOPEC service agreement. The 6% discount will continue during the 3 year period. As part of the agreement, NextEra will direct at least \$10 million of revenue to be used for the construction of renewable energy projects.
