The subject sewers are in poor structural and operational condition specifically with chronic fractures, joint separations, and calcification buildups that limit the design flow capacity of the sewer and allow an excessive amount of infiltration and inflow into the sanitary sewer that has led to systematic basement backups. The defects observed in the two sewer systems also allow for communication of flows between the two which poses a water quality issue with contaminated stormwater discharging directly into Lake Erie.
