

Jahheem and Veronica have a history of neglect and possibly domestic violence. Their ideal family would be one that enjoys childcentered activities while remaining understanding and patient.

Jahheem has autism and is still working on potty training. He lacks awareness of others and verbal skills, which frustrates him and leads to tantrums where he will scream and hit. Jahheem is diagnosed with Thalassemia and is always hungry.

Jahheem is a neat child who enjoys picking up around the house and organizing his belongings. Veronica is a happy helper who will usually help out when asked. The siblings enjoy playing outside and staying active.

Veronica is still working on potty training and has a history of temper tantrums where she will scream and swear. She does have expressive language disorder, which likely plays a role in her tantrums. She has hidden food in the past and has taken things from school or her foster family.

These kiddos will thrive in a structured household, which has been proven through their current placement. Jahheem does receive specialized services, which seems to have had a positive impact on his speech development. Veronica is also in need of specialized services, but remains on a waitlist.
