Jahheem does receive specialized services, which seems to have had a positive impact on his speech development. Jahheem is diagnosed with Thalassemia and is always hungry.

Veronica does have expressive language disorder and she would benefit from speech

services, but has not had the opportunity to begin yet due to being on a waitlist. She can communicate some and this continues to grow as she picks up on what others say around her. She has hidden food in the past and has taken things from school or her foster family.

Jahheem is a neat child who enjoys picking up around the house and organizing his belongings. Veronica is a happy helper who will usually help out when asked. The siblings enjoy playing outside and staying active.

These kiddos will thrive in a structured household. The children do have significant connections with past caregivers, so a family that could maintain these relationships would be best.
